An act to repeal and add Section 8276.3 of the Fish and Game Code, relating to Dungeness crab.

LEGISLATIVE COUNSEL'S DIGEST

SB 1690, as introduced, Wiggins. Dungeness crab.

Existing law prescribes the opening and closing dates of the Dungeness crab fishery season by district, and permits the Director of Fish and Game until April 1, 2010, to delay the opening of the fishery with respect to certain districts based on scheduled quality tests commencing on or about November of each year. Existing law also prohibits a vessel from the taking of crab during any closure.

This bill would repeal the prohibition on the taking of crab during a closure, and would declare the intent of the Legislature to enact legislation that would direct representatives of the Dungeness crab industry to develop a long-term management program for the Dungeness crab fishery to be submitted to the Fish and Game Commission for approval.

The people of the State of California do enact as follows:
